Optional Projects for the Real Fanatics

Option 1 - Examine the role that ethics plays in the political process. Conflicting truth claims, attack ads, voter registration fraud, and other issues dominate the discussion of this political season. Search for article on political ethics and examine them from a Christian worldview perspective. How would things change if candidates and parties applied Christian principles?

Option 2 - Dr. Peter Singer, bioethics professor at Princeton University, is faced with a moral dilemma. Singer believes that the terminally ill, newborns with birth defects, the unborn, and the handicapped are “non-persons” and advocates killing them through “non-voluntary euthanasia.” Yet, Singer has spent thousands of dollars on nursing care for his ailing mother. If you had the opportunity to interview Professor Singer, what questions would you ask him about making moral decisions? Write out your questions and give possible answers from Dr. Singer’s worldview perspective. You might research Singer’s views from his articles on the web.
